Dogs, like small children, require a certain level of consistency in order to thrive. Tragically, under the ***Creature Comforts*** service, dogs are shuttled from one location to another, solely for the benefit of their human counterparts. This service, which claims to be part Match.com and part dog sitting, allows dog owners to locate willing sitters in their local area to fill the hours while an owner is at work, or for vacation or business trips. Questionably, non-pet owners can also sign up for the service to browse pet profiles and volunteer to dogsit. While ***Creature Comforts*** claims to solve the problem of the lonely pet, this service only promotes irresponsible pet ownership. Services like this encourage dog owners to overlook the responsibility and commitment involved in spending time with an animal companion and allows those with disposable income to transfer the responsibility to another individual, with no guarantees of pet ownership history or knowledge.



This inconsistent pet sitting model likely causes more trauma for the dog than being alone all day. Furthermore, this model emphasizes human convenience over the animal's emotional state. Please help put an end to dog cruelty and irresponsible pet ownership.
